

Richmond Branch BCRMTA
Community Service Scholarships
Rules and Regulations

1. To be eligible, the student must be studying with a member of the Richmond Branch of the BCRMTA, for a minimum of one year.
2. The student's teacher must be a Richmond Branch member in good standing and registered in their discipline, for a period of no less than one year.
3. Community service must be related to music.

Examples include playing in senior's homes, at a church, or anywhere they may volunteer their musical skills

OR

assisting in a musical organization such as BCRMTA events, music festival or competition, or a concert association etc.

4. A minimum of 35 hours will be required for the Richmond Branch Community Service Scholarship Award.
5. The students with the three highest hours of service between January 1st and December 31st 2009, will each receive a cash award of \$25 and a certificate.
6. Winners are encouraged to perform on the day of award presentation but are not required to. Please note all performances are to be memorized – excluding ensemble works.

Submission Deadline: February 6, 2010

Presentation of the Richmond Branch Community Service Scholarship Awards will be showcased at the Advanced Students Recital on Mar 27, 2010, Saturday 7pm.
